The Czechoslovak Specialist, has been published continuously by the Society since 1939. The journal carries original, reprinted, and translated articles on all facets of Czechoslovak philately.

The Czechoslovak Specialist is designed to meet the needs of all collectors of philatelic material connected with Czechoslovak philately -- be they beginning collectors or advanced students of philately exhibiting at the international level.

Published quarterly, the journal draws on a wide range of authors writing in several languages.
